## letter from the head golf pro

We would like to invite all of the Membership to participate in the summer tournament schedule. During July and August, there are opportunities to join in some competitive golf. If you have any questions regarding daily play or tournament sign-ups, please call the Golf Pro Shop in advance to check availability.

The *Sliceroo* occurs Thursday, July 13th through Saturday, July 15th with course preparation and a practice round (10:30 a.m. shotgun) scheduled for Wednesday, July 12th. During the *Sliceroo*, the golf course, practice facilities, and Clubhouse dining will be closed except to tournament participants.

We are nearing the quarterfinals of the Scotch Matches. The matches will be posted outside the Golf Pro Shop so you may schedule your time to be part of the gallery. As always, complimentary spectator carts are available to the Membership provided they are available. Please obtain a cart from one of the outdoor service staff to ensure our playing Members have enough carts.

Our caddie program is in its second month and going very well. I would encourage you to give our caddie program a try. These young men and women can assist you in experiencing the enjoyment of golf. Please make sure to call Dillon May, John Kienast, or the Golf Pro Shop staff at least one day in advance to reserve your caddie.

As we experience a higher volume of play, we would like to bring three

important items to your attention.

### Getting to the Tee on Time-

As a courtesy to your fellow Members, players should be on the tee box by their starting time.

We have several time-coordinated clocks so you can plan your practice accordingly. Players not attempting to drive the 1st green should tee off first in the group. Also, please clear the 1st green in a timely manner.

**Pace of Play-** It is important to remember that it is the player's responsibility to play his/her round in the allocated time of four hours or less. The staff is spending many hours monitoring and assisting players with the pace but the players are ultimately responsible for keeping up with the group in front of them. Please make sure you are within one shot of the group in front at all times. **Course Care-** Please utilize the sand/seed bottles on the carts. Don't just repair the divot you made, repair any areas on the golf course. You may have to hit the next shot out of that divot if it is not fixed!



## letter from the gm



### Master Plan Information

With the arrival of July, the Master Plan construction project on the golf course will be starting in approximately 6 weeks. The most important piece of information for the Membership to be aware of; **the course is not closed during construction.** We will have as many holes open for play, as determined by where Total Turf and Gil Hanse will be working.

I would ask that the Membership be patient and flexible during this process, as the construction crews will be large in size and working in various locations at one time. The time line is quick for this project, lasting about 10 to 12 weeks in total. Weather would be the only caveat in delaying the project. The goal is to have all greens completed and planted by October 1st, with the remaining work on fairway's, tee's, and rough to be completed by November 1st.

Construction will begin on the hole 10 & 6 green complex. Hole 10 will be closed entirely, as there will be no room during the project to implement a temporary green. From there, we expect hole 14 green and fairway to be the next area of disruption. From this point, we are not exactly sure where Gil and his teams will be disbursed, irrigation and planting of grasses will be the determining factors on where construction will go from there. We feel hole 4 will be the last position they will work on – we can implement a temporary green on 4 while crews work on the new green complex.

Gil Hanse is very sensitive to our Membership, he will work in harmony with play on the course. We as a Membership will need to be flexible in starting and ending positions while this project is under way. The Golf Committee will look at various tournament options for the Membership as well during the project, to allow our Membership to continue with the camaraderie through the golf events that makes Lakewood so special.

This is an exciting time for Lakewood, while most of us feel the golf course is already a great layout, this restoration will prepare our Club to be competitive in the private sector for decades to come. I realize this is an inconvenience for our current Membership, but it's a vested interest into our future that must occur. The time of disruption to our Membership ultimately is very short, compared to the return on investment we are gaining for our long-term benefit.

Soon you will be seeing routes and plans of disruption in areas around the Clubhouse, to provide the Membership with the most up to date information. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask me and I will answer those questions to best of my ability.
