# letter from the gm



Facilities Master Plan

As I write this letter, we are in the beginning stages of construction for the Golf Course Master Plan. The culmination of over 20 years of

planning are becoming a reality. This is a wonderful and exciting time to be a Member of Lakewood Country Club!

Starting two years ago, under the guidance of Mark Wehrle as President, the Board of Directors put forth a plan to fund the execution of the Master Plan, designed by Gil Hanse. Last year's Board of Directors and President, Wyck Brown, implemented the project; with a popular vote from the Membership, and secured the funding to complete this golf course restoration. It will be this year's Board and President, Tim Brooks, to see this process to completion.

Over 20 years of discussion and planning, and three years to coordinate, fund, and finish the product. We now set our sights on a second Master Plan, for the facilities. Our golf course will be a product that can compete for top honors in the Denver Metro for years to come, now it's time to shift some focus on our long-range plans for the facilities.

The Facilities Committee, chaired by Danette Reagan, has been charged with developing a Master Plan for the Clubhouse and pool. With an average turnover of 6% annually in our Membership, we are seeing a younger, family demographic joining our Club year after year. Our Facilities, while beautiful, are in some ways too small or out of date to meet the demands of our newer Membership as well as our incumbent Members. To stay competitive in the marketplace, we need to focus on the areas of our Clubhouse that are underutilized or overburdened.

This year's Board, is taking on the task of securing resources to help us plan for our immediate needs as well as long term future. The first step will be to send out a survey for the Membership to offer feedback on what is important to them. This survey will be coming out shortly, allowing all categories of Membership the opportunity to rank from most important to the least important on multiple ideas brought to the Facilities Committee. These rankings will provide information for the Board to dedicate funds and resources to pursue these enhancements.

I hope you all will take three minutes to fill out the survey. It is vital information, and can put the wheels in motion for our next big enhancement for our already fantastic Club.




