

## USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

except as modified by local ground rules.

- Interior “Out of Bounds” defined by fences and/or white stakes on holes 1, 8, 9, 10, and 16. All parking lots are “Out of Bounds.”
- Play as lateral water hazard: water east of 16 fairway and 17 green, south of 10 and 14 green, and north of 12 fairway.
- Embedded Ball Rule: Lakewood has adopted the local embedded ball rule, where if your ball embeds in its own pitch mark in the ground, except in loose sand, anywhere “through the green,” it may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay, but not nearer the hole. “Through the green” is the whole area of the course, except the teeing ground and the putting green of the hole being played, and all hazards on the course.
- Tree Wells: Relief is not allowed from tree wells and the wood chips within them. Relief would be granted if the tree is staked, no nearer the hole.
- Flower Beds: These are considered immovable obstructions. Relief must be taken at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.
- French Drains: Relief is granted from the small gravel drainage ditches (nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole).
- Curbing: All wood and concrete curbing along the cart paths are considered part of the cart path. Railroad ties and/or landscape concrete blocks used in the construction of tees, retaining walls, and water hazards are considered an integral part of the golf course and no relief is granted.
- USGA-approved yardage finders are approved for daily and tournament play.
